Exchange Black Friday sales begin midnight Central time on Nov. 26 at ShopMyExchange.com. Exchange main stores worldwide will be closed

on Thanksgiving prior to reopening at 0800 the next day.

At most locations, authorized Exchange shoppers can avoid traditional holiday shopping crowds with buy online, pick up in store and curbside pickup contactless services.

Those who choose to shop in person will find clean, sanitized stores, malls and restaurants. This year's tradition of Black Friday shopping will look much different than prior years due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but our team's commitment to protecting the force remains the same.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, our lifestyles have significantly changed. The Exchange is providing careers for the military community as it closes in on its goal to hire 50,000 Veterans and military spouses by the end of 2020. Since 2013, the Exchange has hired more than 46,000 Veterans and military spouses. Today, approximately 85% of Exchange associates share a connection with the military.

Working for the Exchange is a Quality-of-Life force multiplier for military families, with Veterans and spouses receiving hiring preference. The Exchange's associate transfer program gives military spouses an opportunity to retain employment through PCSs, allowing them to keep their benefits and offering retirement opportunities as they move with their Soldier or Airmen.

Since 2017, honorably discharged Veterans have been able to shop the Exchange online tax-free at ShopMyExchange.com.

This year also marks the first holiday shopping season since the Exchange welcomed more than 4.1 million disabled Veterans and certain caregivers back to their in-store shopping benefit on Jan. 1, 2020.

By shopping the Exchange, Veterans help those who wear the uniform today. 100% of Exchange earnings are reinvested in our military community, in part through dividends for Qualityof-Life programs including Child, Youth and School Services; Armed Forces Recreation Centers; and more. In the last 10 years, the Exchange has generated \$2.2 billion for these critical programs.
