MILITARY STAR Offers Flexibility and Everyday Savings



The Exchange and the MILITARY STAR card are prioritizing savings for military communities.



Service members and families who use their MILITARY STAR card save 5 cents on every gallon of gas at Exchange fuel locations and 10% on all food purchases at Exchange restaurants. Any ShopMyExchange.com orders made with MILITARY STAR automatically receive free shipping.

The MILITARY STAR card never charges any annual, late or over-limit fees and has one low APR for everyone, regardless of credit score—which can be a big help to younger service members just starting out, as well as anyone looking to build stronger credit. The average store credit card interest rate is 29.99%—more than double the MILITARY STAR APR of 14.74% that is offered to all cardholders.
