

ARMY GREEN SERVICE UNIFORM

HEADGEAR

The service cap is a unisex cap. It is a military-style peaked cap with heritage walnut 567 leather visor, rigid standing front, circular rim with hatband, and cap cover of the same shade and material as the coat. The sides of the cap fold down.

All Soldiers may wear the service cap as an optional headgear with the AGSU.

Enlisted insignia is a plain, gold-colored disk, 1 – 1/2 inches in diameter, with a gold-colored metal coat of arms of the United States attached to the disk. Secured through the front eyelet.

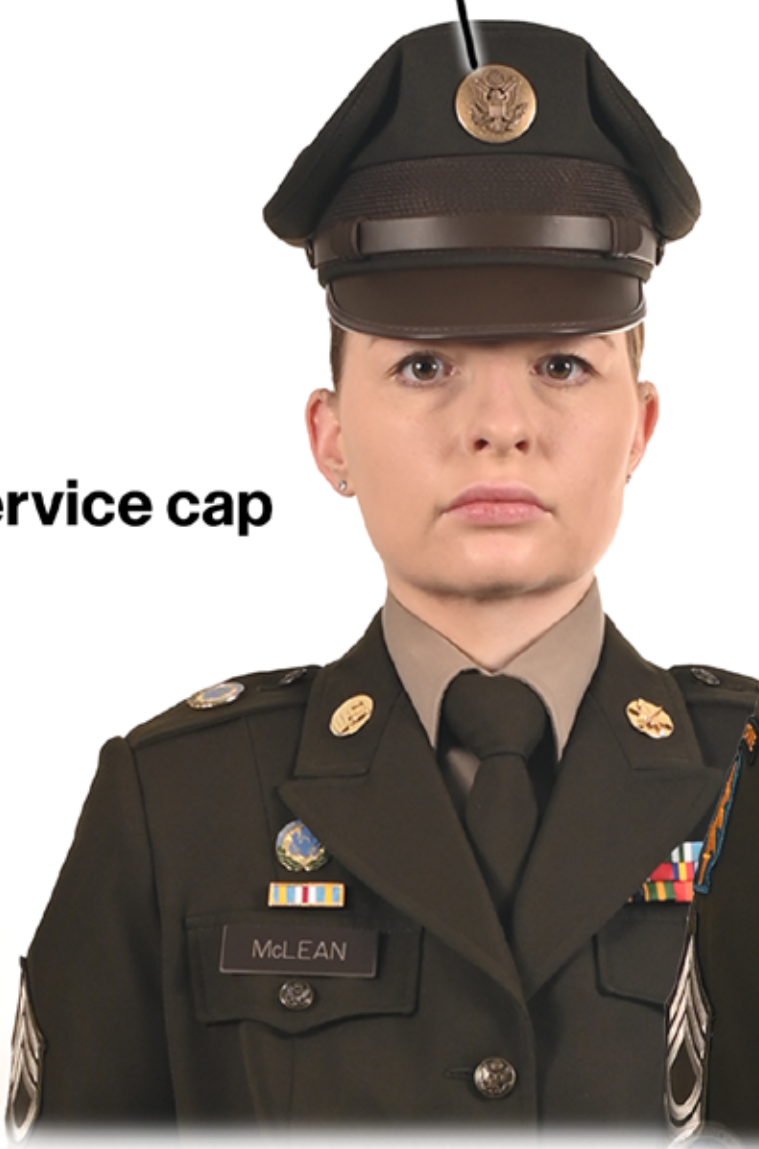


The garrison cap may be worn by all personnel with Class A or B AGSU. The garrison cap is worn with the front vertical crease of the cap centered on the forehead in a straight line with the nose, with the front lower portion of the cap approximately 1 inch above the eyebrows (approximately the width of the first two fingers).

Distinctive unit insignia (DUI): Enlisted personnel will wear their DUI on the garrison cap on the left curtain 1 inch from the front crease.

Visor: The visor is plain heritage walnut 567 leather.

Chinstrap and chinstrap ornamentation: The chinstrap consists of two straps, each 5/8 inch wide by 9 – 5/8 inches long, with one end of each strap forming a slide and the other end of each strap fastened to the cap at each end of the visor. The chinstrap is plain leather matching the visor in appearance and shade with rounded ends.

Officer insignia is the coat of arms of the United States, 2 – 3/8 inches in height, in gold-colored metal. It is worn by commissioned officers and warrant officers. Secured through the front eyelet.



Personnel will not crush or shape the crown of the cap to form peaks at the top front or top rear of the cap

Rank: Officers will wear nonsubdued grade insignia on the garrison cap centered on the left curtain 1 inch from the front crease.
