

ARMY GREEN SERVICE UNIFORM

EISENHOWER (IKE) JACKET

Rank: Soldiers are required to embroider their current rank on the Ike Jacket.



Commissioned and warrant officers can wear embroidered or pin-on rank on the shoulder loops.



Service Stripes and Overseas Service Bars: Officer and Enlisted will wear sewn-on SSI and SSI – MOHC, and overseas service bars as appropriate.



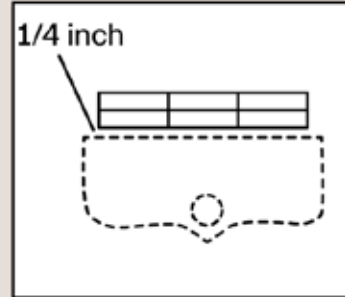
The necktie: Soldiers have the option of wearing a tie when they wear the Eisenhower jacket. If a tie is worn with the jacket, Soldiers will wear the collar of the shirt inside the sweater.

Buttons: Personnel will wear the Ike fastened to at least the second button down from the top of the jacket.

Shirt: To be worn with Class A or Class B variation.



Service Ribbons: Ribbons will be worn in the same manner as the AGSU tropical dress variation. No more than six ribbons.



Medals and Badges: will be worn in accordance with AGSU guidance. Unless directed by a commander in accordance with AR 670 – 1, authorized awards are worn at the option of the wearer, when not prohibited, during normal duty hours.



Combat and special skill badges and tabs: Will be worn on the Ike jacket in the same manner as the AGSU Class A.



Identification Badge: Only one identification badge may be worn per side or pocket of the Ike Jacket.
